## WEST BOWL

### Alpine Powder Bowl to Tree Glades

With your choice of drop-ins, this area offers some of the most varied wilderness skiing and riding in Canada. Recommended to ski with a buddy and avalanche gear.

### Getting Around

**JUNIPER EXPRESS** to **PIPESTONE EXPRESS** to **SUMMIT CHAIR**. West Bowl is accessed from the top of Summit via stairs 100 metres down on **Boomerang**, or midway down **Outer Limits**. Exit via **Egress** to the Front Side.

## FRONT SIDE

### Fun For All Skiers and Riders

The widest variety of runs at Lake Louise, including all learning areas and terrain parks.

### Getting Around

Beginners will enjoy shorter, easier runs from **JUNIPER EXPRESS** or **GLACIER EXPRESS** via **Wiwaxy**. More adventurous skiers can connect to **PIPESTONE EXPRESS**, **TOP OF THE WORLD EXPRESS** and **SUMMIT CHAIR** for more challenging terrain, and access to the **Back Bowls**, **Paradise** & **Larch**. Return to Front Side via **PARADISE CHAIR** or **PTARMIGAN CHAIR**.



Powder Keg Lounge, Kuma Yama, Banded Peak Base Camp and Whitehorn Bistro are all on the Front Side.

## LARCH

### Wide Groomers & Fun Exploration

Perfect for beginner and intermediate skiers looking to expand their horizons, do some big turns and even find some epic tree lines.

### Getting Around

Take any route to the back side - the easiest route is **GRIZZLY GONDOLA** - and follow any run all the way down to reach the **LARCH EXPRESS**. To return from Larch, take **PTARMIGAN CHAIR** back to the Front Side.



Don't miss a stop-in at Temple Lodge and Sawyer's Nook for a bite to eat.



## RICHARDSON'S RIDGE



### Gateway To Glades

Lake Louise's newest terrain addition, with accessible, low-angle green and blue runs and fun glades — great for beginners and intermediates ready to roam and explore.

### Getting Around



Take any route to the back side - the easiest and most direct is **GRIZZLY GONDOLA** - and follow **Pika** run to reach **RICHARDSON'S RIDGE EXPRESS**.

To return to the Front Side, take **PARADISE CHAIR** or **PTARMIGAN CHAIR**.

## PARADISE



### Chutes, Steeps & Moguls

True alpine thrills featuring daring drops and steep expert terrain, Paradise is a must-do for any skier looking to challenge themselves and experience the essence of riding in the Rockies.

### Getting Around



**GRIZZLY GONDOLA** or **PTARMIGAN CHAIR** to **Pika** for the easiest route to **PARADISE CHAIR**. Otherwise, any **Back Bowl** run will lead you there. **PARADISE CHAIR** also accesses the Front Side.

## BACK BOWLS



### Endless Adventure

The heart and soul of powder skiing at Lake Louise, with so much to explore. Don't miss **Boomerang** for some of the best scenery Lake Louise has to offer! Challenge yourself in the extreme terrain **Alphabet Gullies** and **E.R.** runs off the backside.

### Getting Around



**JUNIPER EXPRESS** to **PIPESTONE EXPRESS** or **GLACIER EXPRESS** to **TOP OF THE WORLD EXPRESS**. Access the **Back Bowls** directly from here or take **SUMMIT CHAIR** to make your way to the outer **Back Bowls**. Return to Front Side via **PARADISE CHAIR** or **PTARMIGAN CHAIR**.
